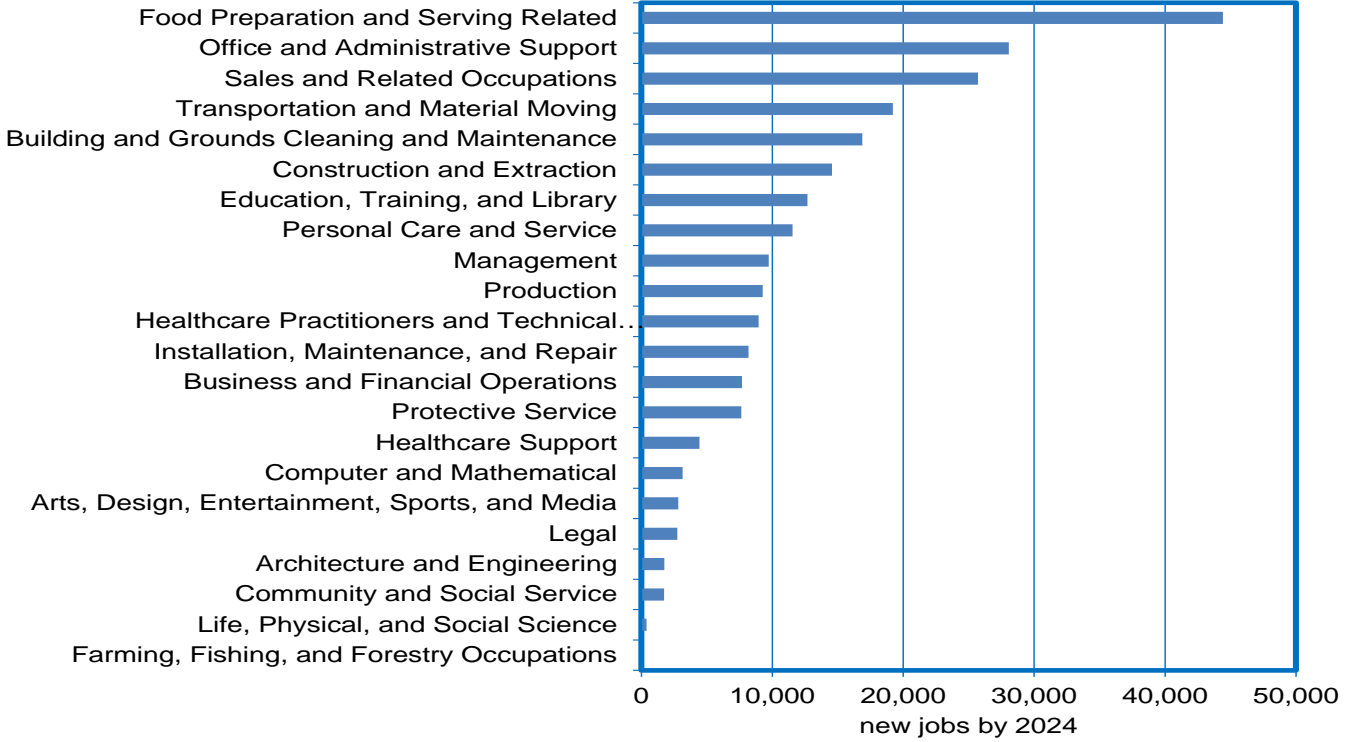

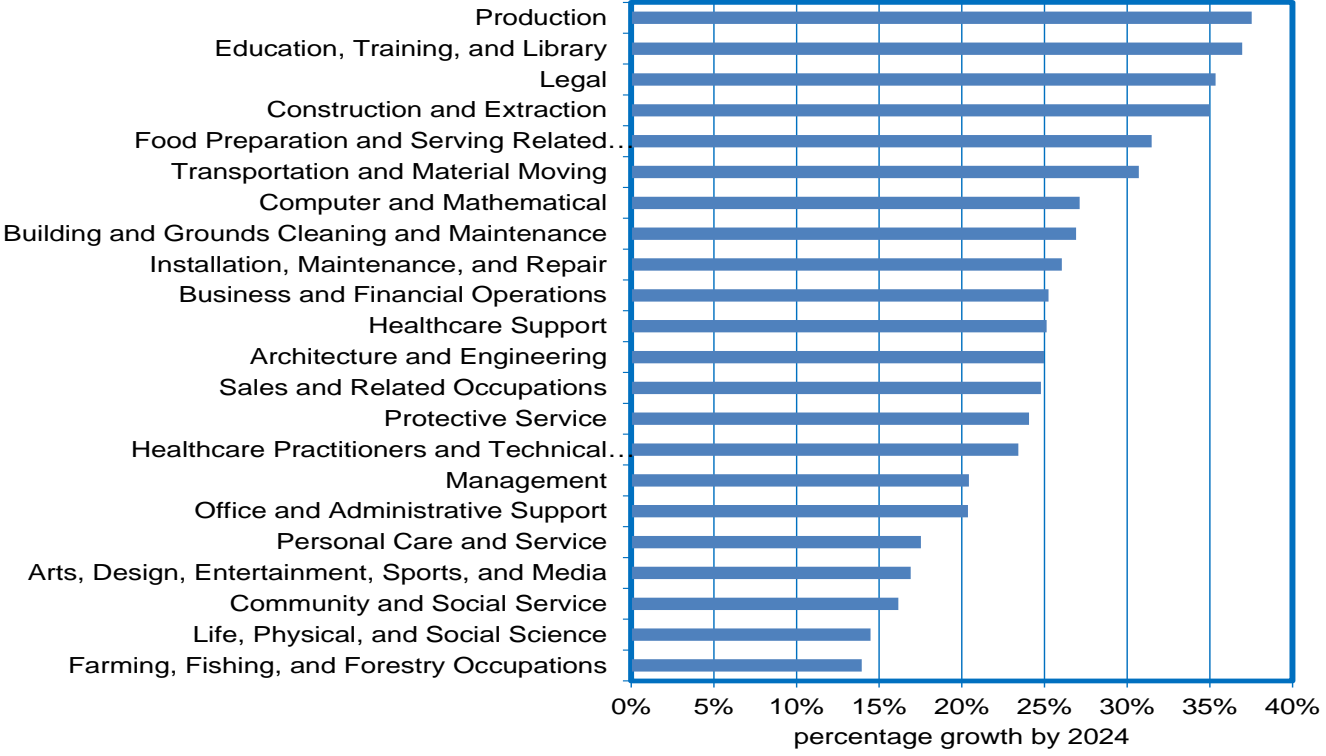

Food Prep, Office Support, and Sales Occupations Lead the Way in Total New Jobs in Southern Nevada

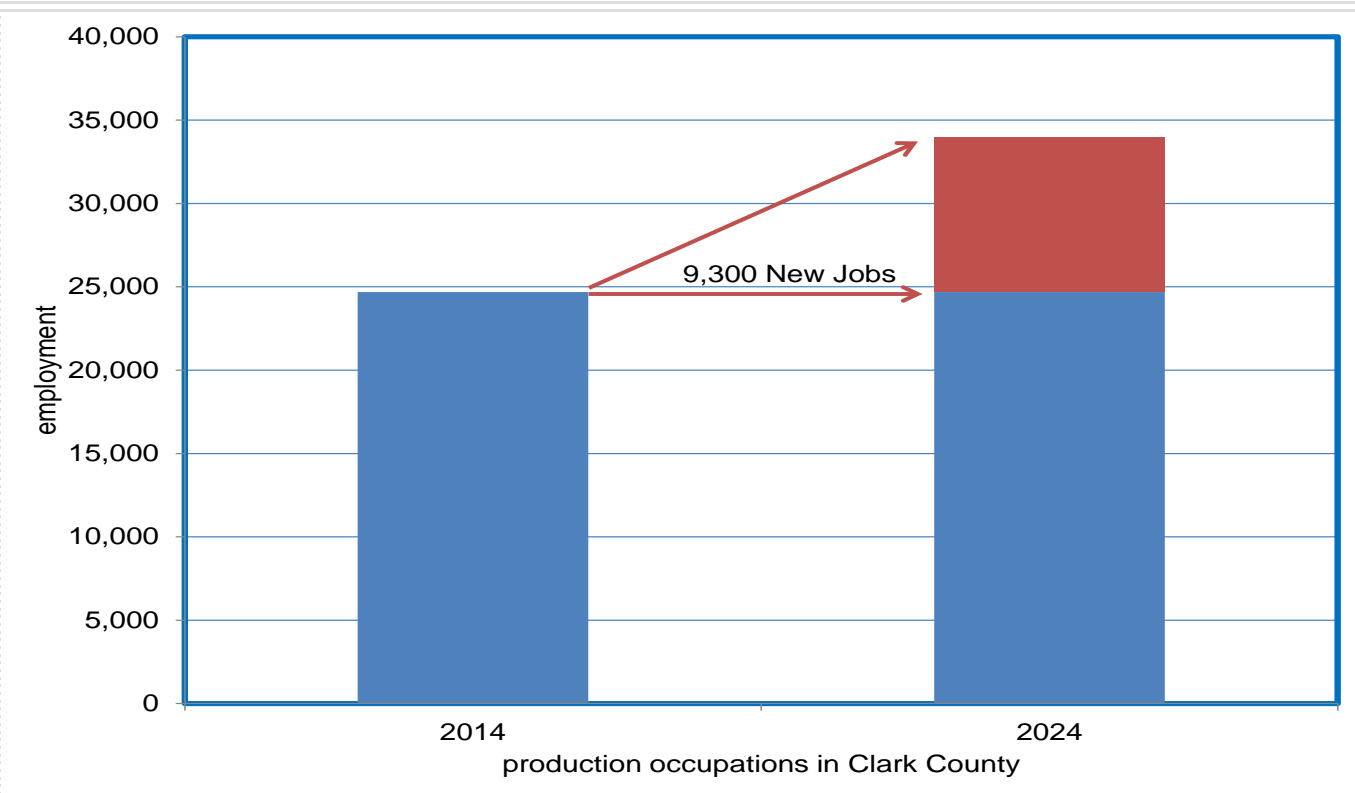


Production, Education, and Legal Occupations to Grow at Highest Rates in Southern Nevada

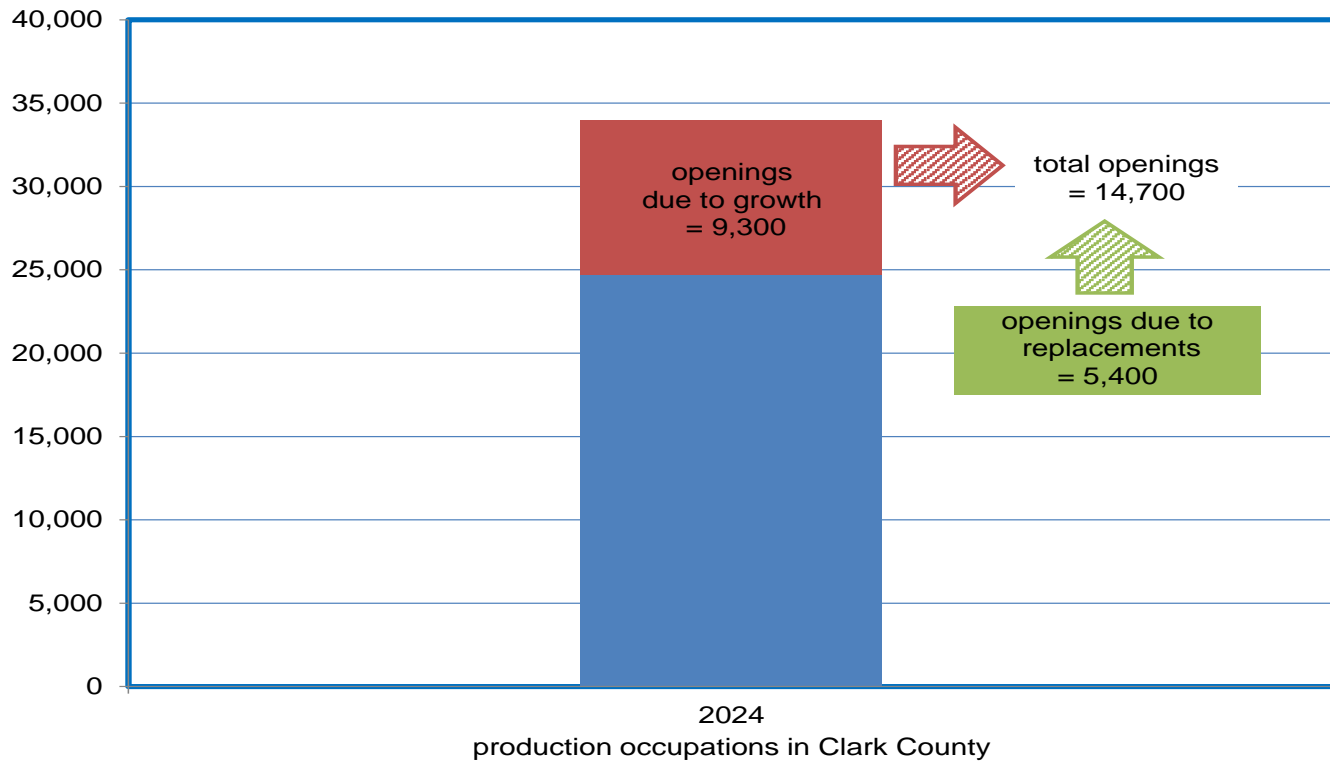

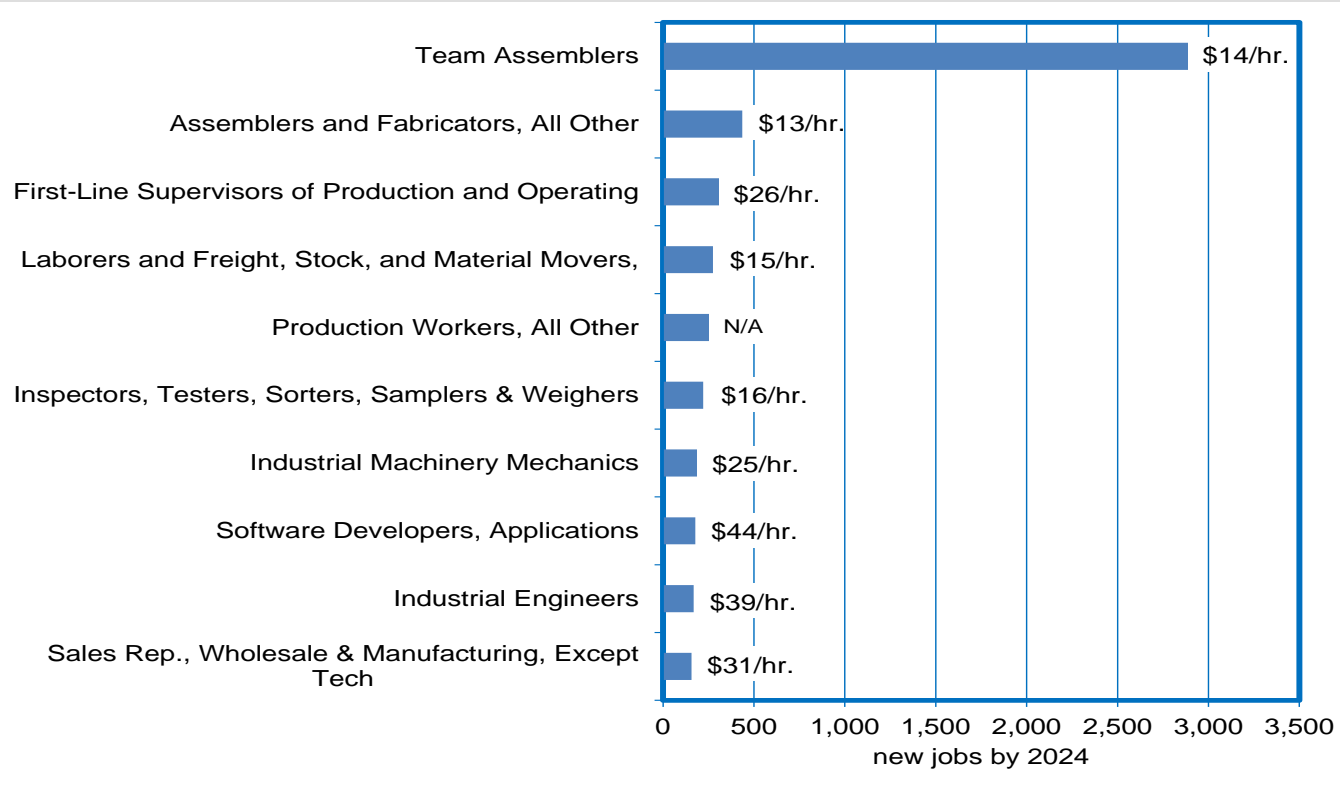
Production Occupations in Southern Nevada Projected to Reach Almost 34k by 2024; Gain 9,300 New Jobs



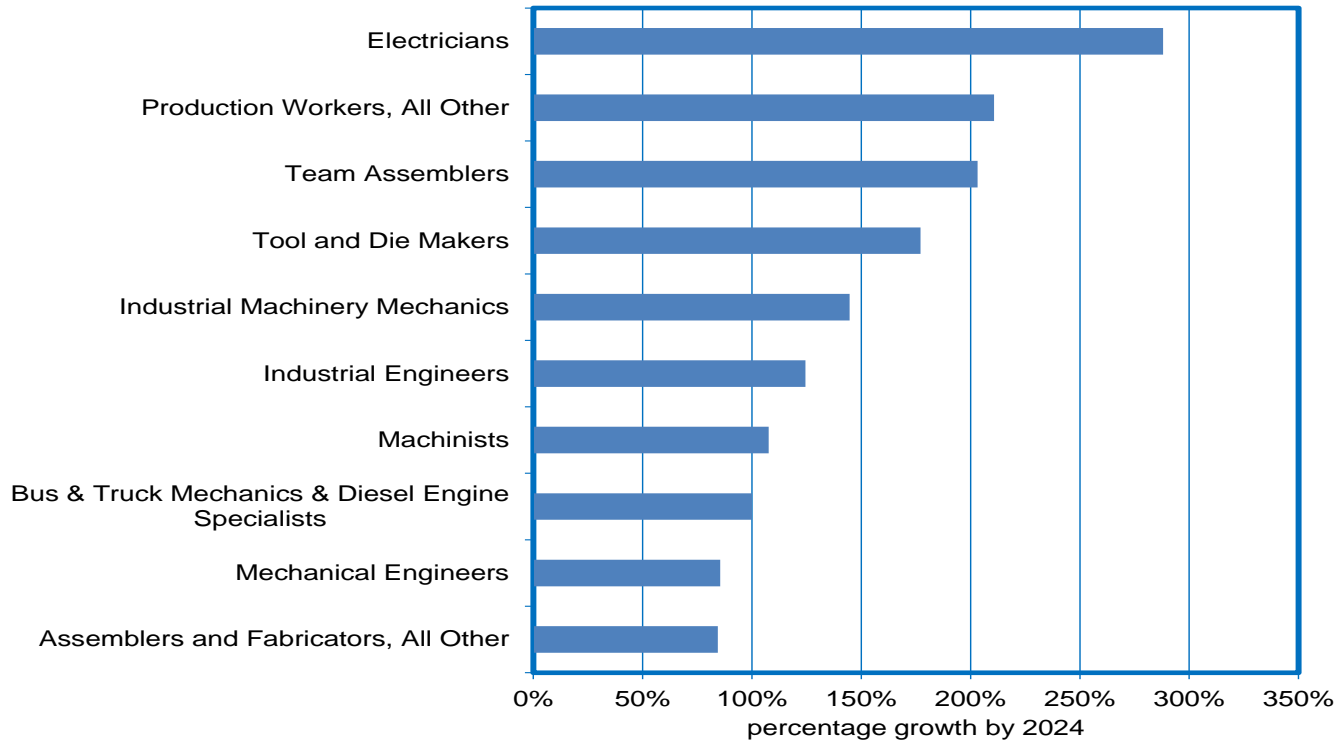

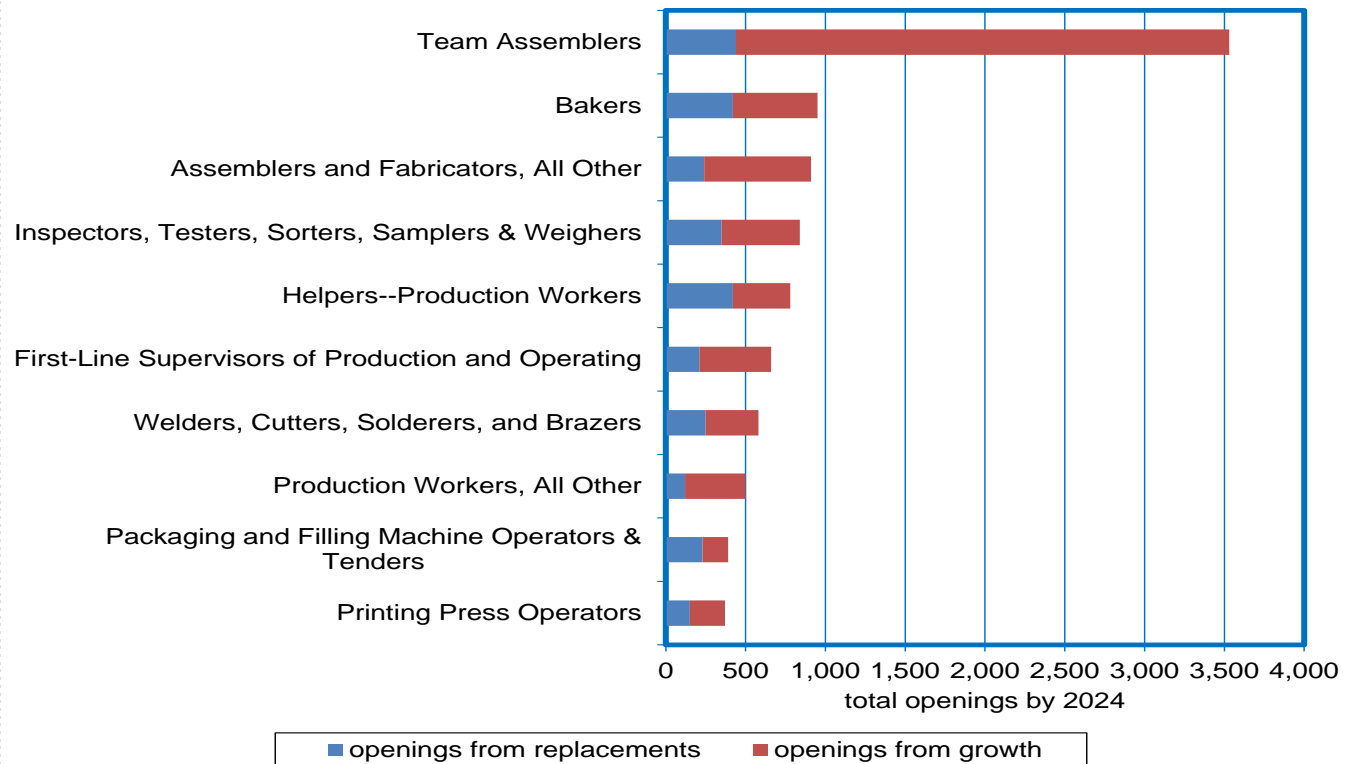
Team Assemblers Lead the Way in New Manufacturing Jobs, Followed by Assemblers and First-Line Supervisors



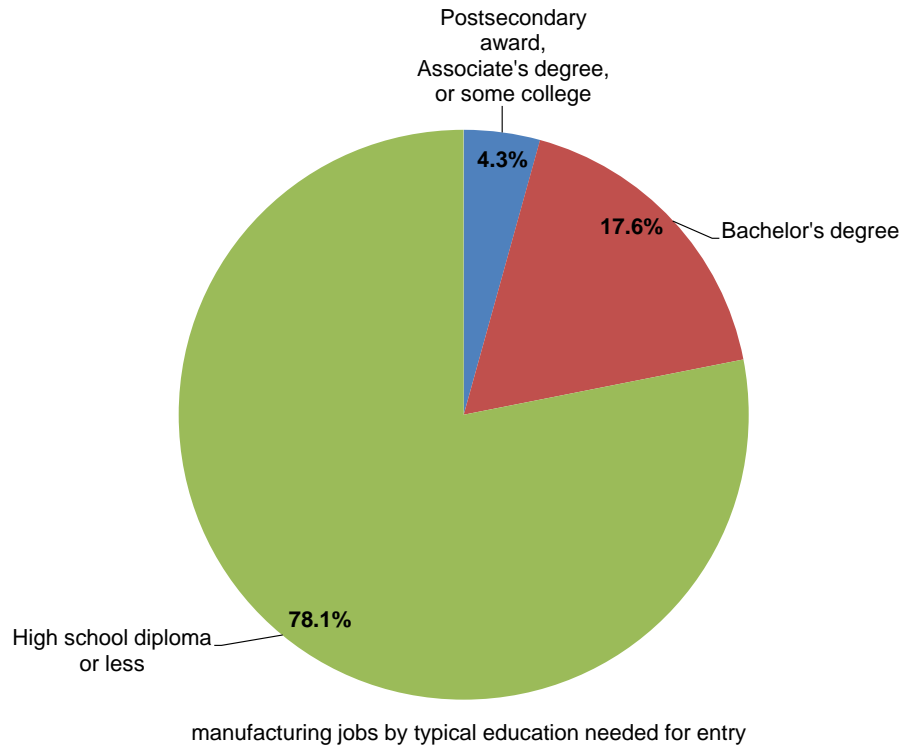
Electricians, Production Workers, and Team Assemblers in Manufacturing Industries Expected to Grow by More than 200%
