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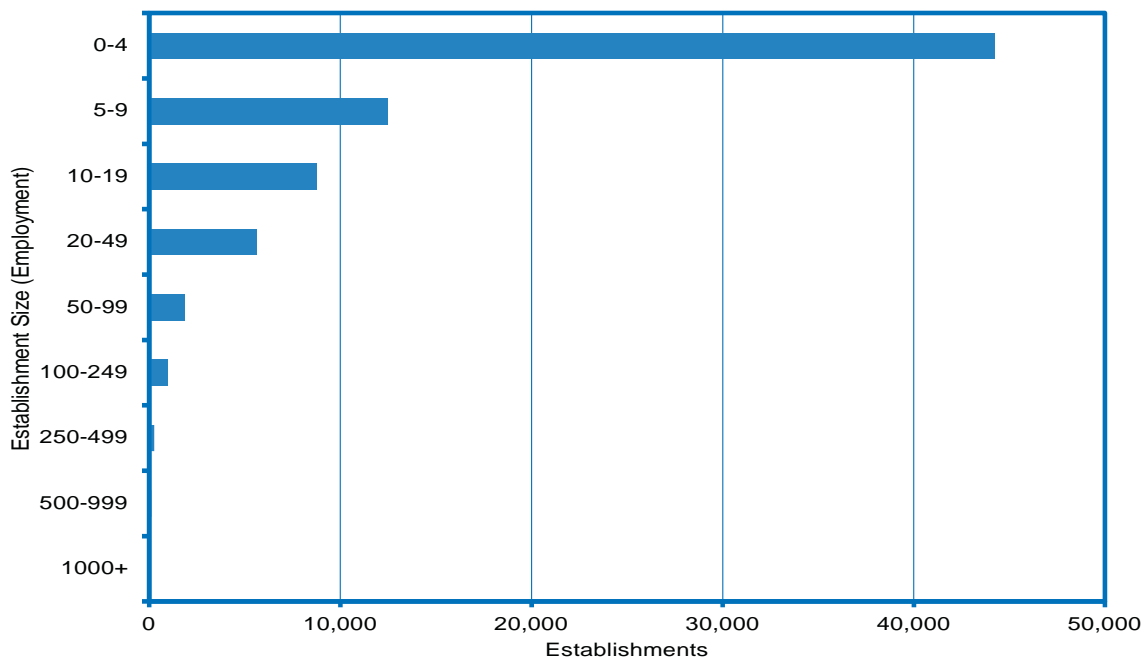

Nevada's Economy Dominated by Small Establishments Number of Nevada Employers by Establishment Size



- Nevada's economy is dominated by small firms (defined as those with less than 100 employees). All told, there are more than 75,000 private sector worksites Statewide.
- The largest establishment size category incorporates those with 0-4 employees, accounting for approximately 60 percent (44,000) of all worksites.
- The next four largest categories (ranging in size from 5-99 workers) account for nearly all the remaining establishments.
- When combined, worksites with less than 100 account for a little over 98 percent of all establishments in Nevada.
- Large and medium size establishments, those with 100 or more employees, account for only 1.9 percent of worksites Statewide. There are around 1,400 worksites with more than 100 employees, including 80 with more than 1,000.
