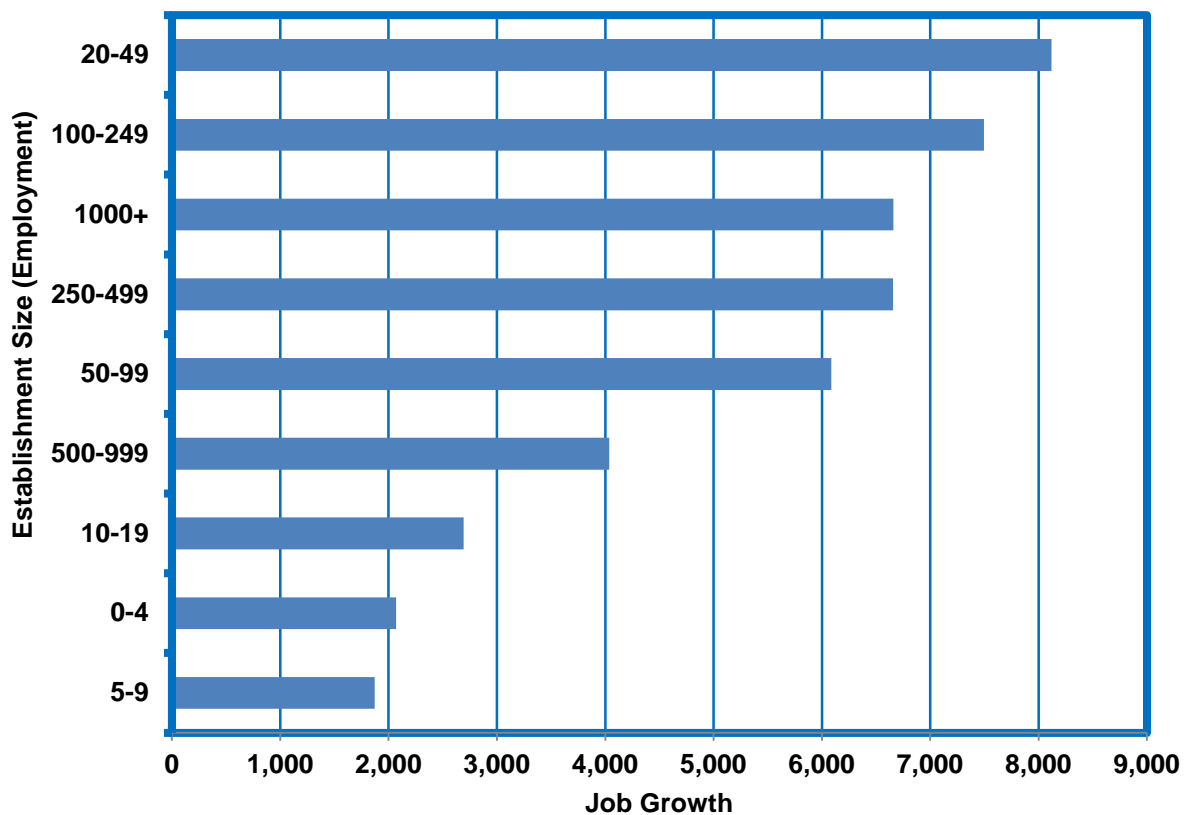


Job Growth by Establishment Size

Big Job Gains in Establishments with 20-49 Workers; Mid-Size/Large Establishments also showed Solid Gains;

2013: 2014: Annual Average Job Growth by Establishment Size



- When comparing 2013 to 2014 annual average's, private sector establishments of 20-49 employees experienced the strongest job growth (+8,118). In this category, the super sector experiencing the strongest growth was leisure and hospitality, especially in limited service and full service restaurants.
- The establishment size category with the next strongest growth included those with 100-249 workers. All told, the growth has totaled just under 7,500 at (+7,496) over the past year. Although this category was also dominated by the leisure and hospitality super sector, retail stores, not restaurants, were primarily responsible for the growth.
- The third largest growth class's were in the 1000+ and 250-499 workers category's both where at (+6,600). In both classes leisure and hospitality accounted for more than any other super sector contributing over 25 percent of the job growth in those establishments.
- All told, establishments with less than 100 workers added 20,836 jobs over the year.
