

Nevada's Top Export Products (2014)



- Information from the Census Bureau's Foreign Trade Division shows Nevada's top export commodity is primary metal manufactures (e.g., refined gold). In 2014 this commodity represented 38% of the State's total exports (\$7.7 billion), at \$2.9 billion.
- Exports of computer and electronic products totaled \$1.6 billion, 21 percent of all exports.
- Miscellaneous manufactured commodities (e.g., gaming equipment) were Nevada's third largest export accounting for 12 percent (\$926 million) of total exports.
- Other exports included: mineral and ores (\$598 million), machinery except electrical (\$261 million), electrical equipment/appliances and components (\$193 million), fabricated metal products (\$190 million), transportation equipment (\$183 million), food manufactures (\$172 million), and chemicals (\$146 million).
