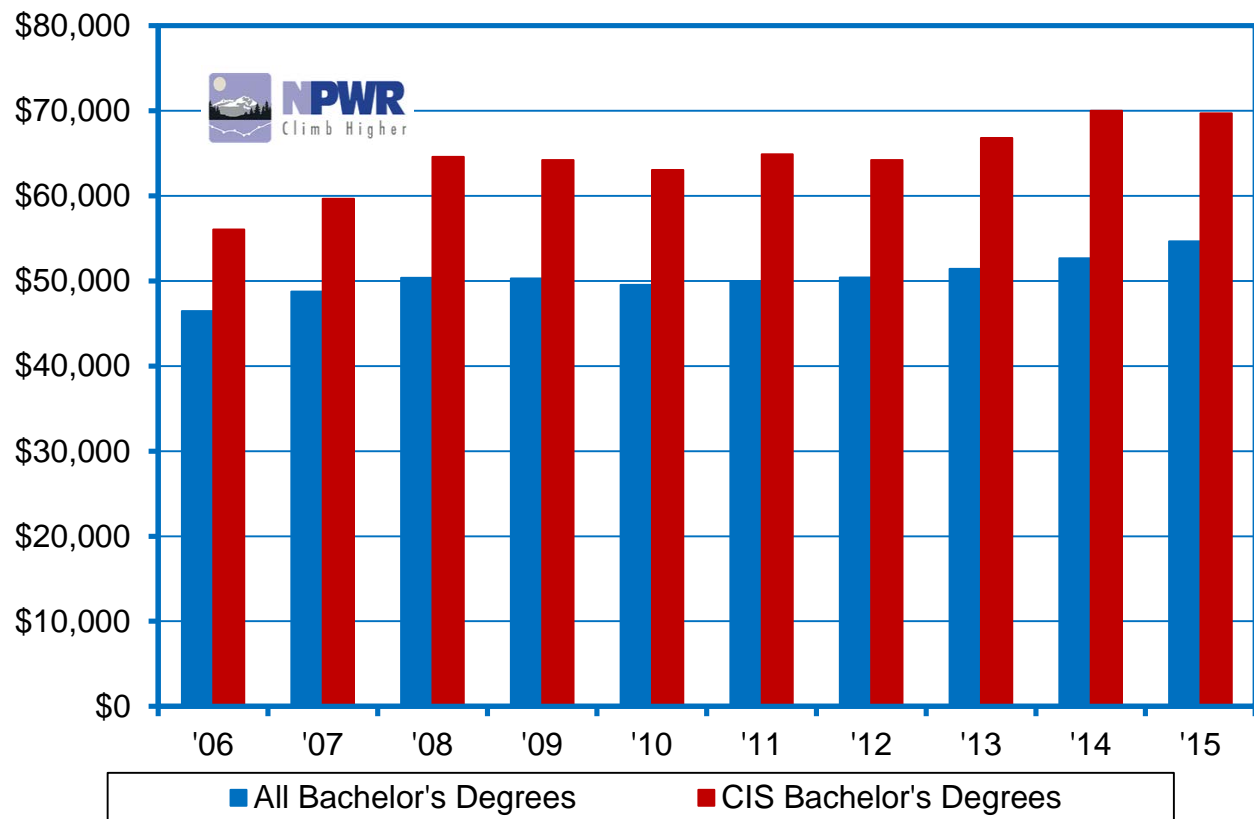

Bachelor's Degree Recipients with CIS Concentrations Earn Approximately 25% More than all Bachelor's Degree Holders



- Governor Sandoval has declared December to be Computer Science Careers Month in Nevada. This Research Note uses the Nevada P-20 to Workforce Research Data System (NPWR) to compare in-State median earnings of Computer and Information Sciences and Support Services Bachelor's Degrees (CIS) to the median earnings of all Bachelor's Degree holders.
- NPWR's Wage by Education Level report allows us to examine the in-State wages for individuals who have earned a degree at a Nevada System of Higher Education (NSHE) institution in the last 35 years.
- Over the past decade, CIS Bachelor's Degree holders have earned median wages that have been approximately 25% greater than the median wages for all Bachelor's Degrees, on average.
- In 2015, CIS Bachelor's Degree earners had median earnings of \$69,700. This was \$15,000 greater than the median earnings for all Bachelor's Degrees (\$54,660).
