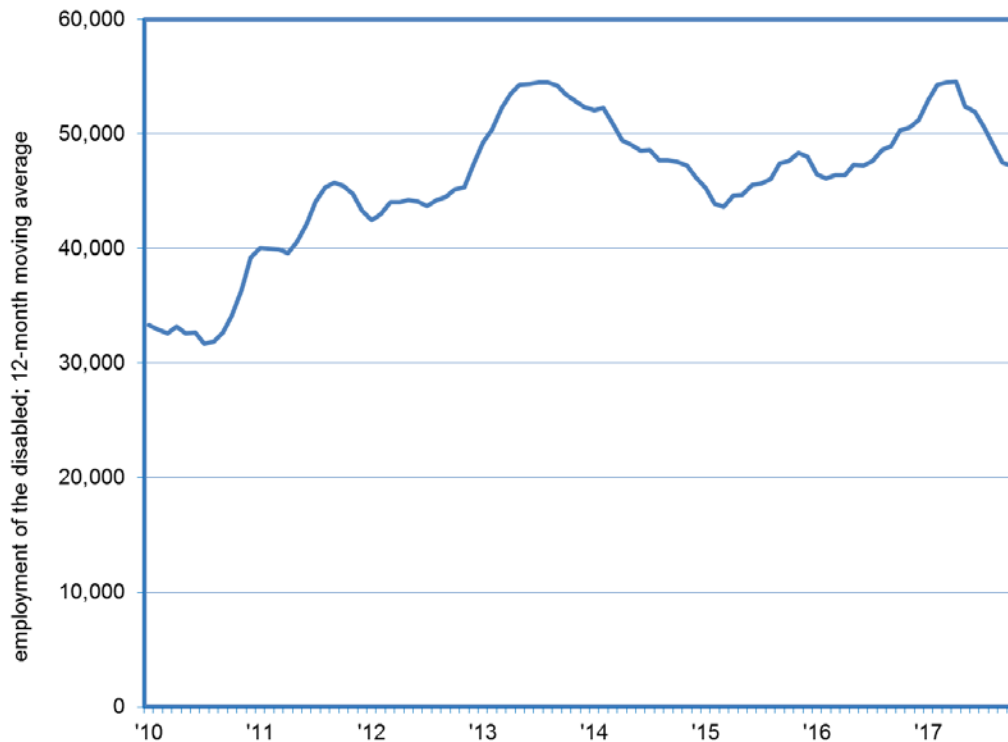

## Employment of Nevadans with Disabilities Trending Up; 47,300 Over Past Year Compared to 34,200 in 2010



- October was National Disability Employment Awareness Month. Information from the monthly Current Population Survey allows for the analysis of employed persons with a disability in Nevada.
- Employment of Nevadans with a disability stood at 34,200 in October 2010 (expressed as a 12-month moving average). This was 17.4 percent of all Nevadans with a disability, compared to 18.6 percent nationwide.
- Since then, employment of persons with disabilities in the Silver State has been trending up. For the 12-month period ending in October 2017, employment stands at 47,300, up 13,100 from 2010. This represents 18.5 percent of all Nevadans with a disability, which is the same rate as the nation as a whole.
