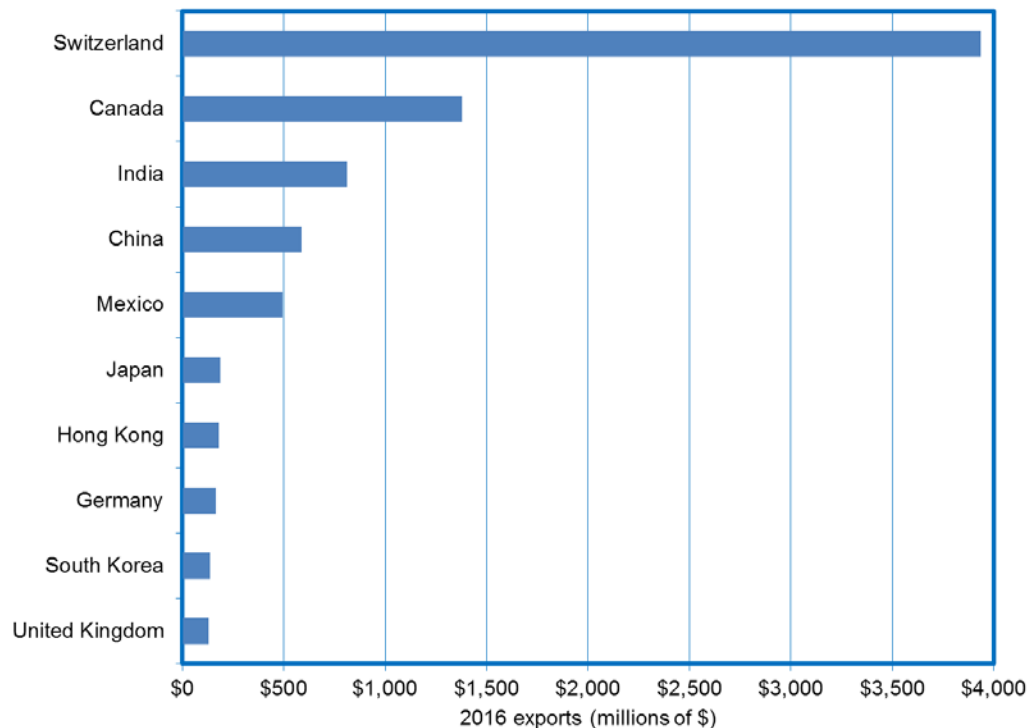

## Nevada Exports Totaled \$9.7 Billion in 2016; Switzerland, Canada and India are Nevada's Largest Trade Partners



- Information from the Census Bureau's Foreign Trade Division shows Nevada exports totaled \$9.7 billion in 2016. The State's largest export was primary metal manufactures (e.g., refined gold), followed by computer/electronics products, and miscellaneous manufactures (e.g., gaming equipment).
- The Silver State's top trade partner is Switzerland (\$3.9 billion in Nevada exports in 2016). Primary metal manufacturing accounted for 99% of Nevada exports to this market.
- Exports to Canada totaled \$1.3 billion. Primary metal manufactures represented 27% of total exports to our northern neighbor.
- Nevada's third-largest trade partner is India, with \$812 million in exports. Primary metal manufactures accounted for 86% of the State's exports to this market.
- Rounding out Nevada's top ten trading partners are: China, Mexico, Japan, Hong Kong, Germany, South Korea and United Kingdom.
