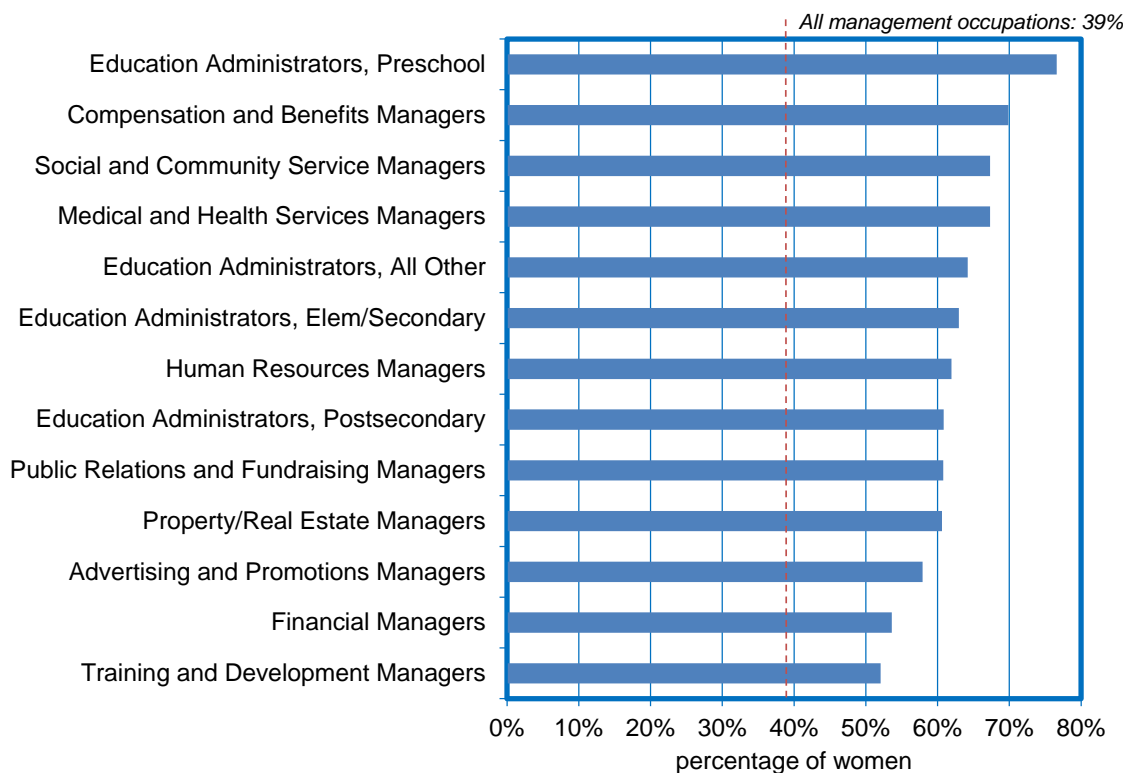

## Women Strongly Represented in Many Business and Education Management Positions



- Both in Nevada and across the United States, women represented almost 40% of all management occupations in 2016. This *Research Note* presents management occupations in which women represent more than half of all employment in the Silver State.
- The majority of all education administrators, from preschool to postsecondary, are women. The percentage of women is highest for preschool/childcare center administrators, at almost 77%, and lowest for postsecondary administrators, at 61%.
- Female managers are also prevalent in business, making up more than half of all managers of compensation/benefits, human resources, public relations, advertising, training/development, and finance.
- In addition, women were also strongly represented amongst social/community service managers and medical/health services managers.
- As an aside, those management occupations in which women are least represented include architecture/engineering, construction, and industrial production.
