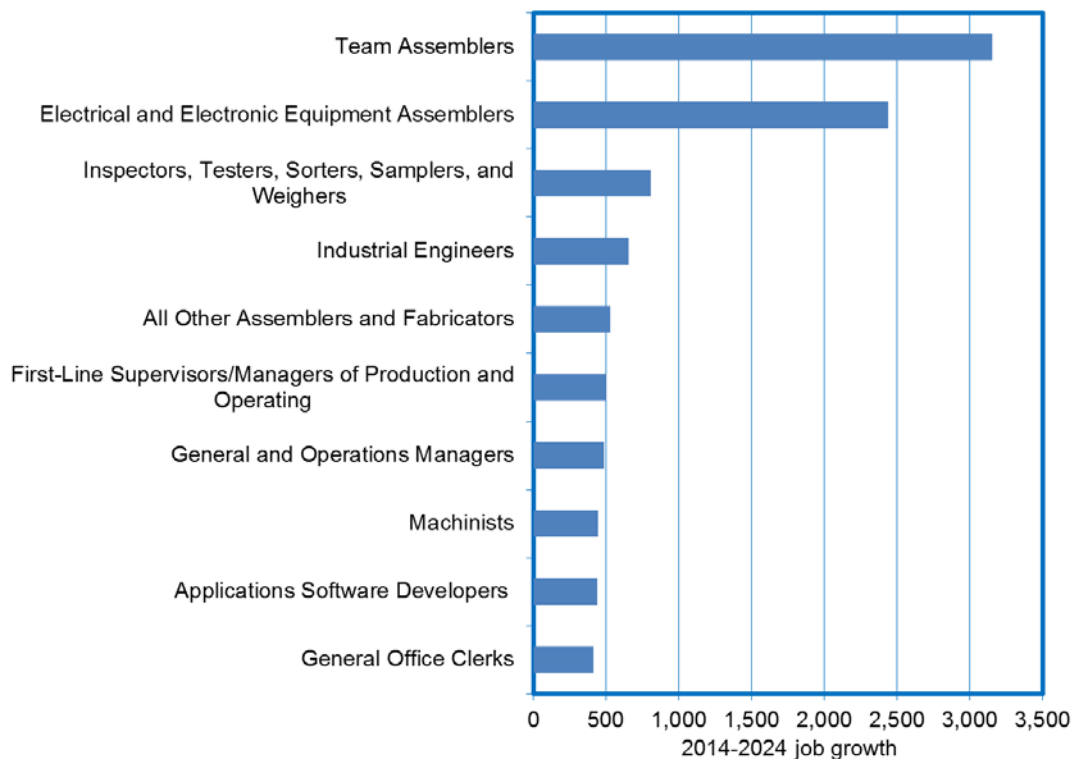
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Manufacturing Occupations Projections  
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## Team Assemblers and Electrical/Electronic Equipment Assemblers Lead the Way in Manufacturing Occupation Growth Through 2024



- The Research and Analysis Bureau produces ten-year occupational employment projections for the State and sub-State areas on a biennial basis.
- Projections are based on a variety of modeling techniques. They are focused on long-term structural trends in the economy and do not try to anticipate future business cycle activity.
- Employment as team assemblers is expected to grow by 3,100 from 2014 to 2024. This is a 116 percent increase over the period.
- Electrical and electronic equipment assemblers are estimated to generate 2,400 new jobs, a 306 percent increase over the same period.
- Inspectors/sorters, with 800 new jobs, are projected to grow 102 percent over the period.
- All told, of the 10 manufacturing occupations projected to have the most pronounced growth, each is estimated to increase over 400 jobs through 2024.
- Estimates of the potential impacts of some well-publicized economic development projects (Tesla and Faraday) are reflected in these projections.
