


County Weekly Wage: Part II Tim Wilcox, Economist

9 of 17 Counties Realize Pay Increases from 2015:IQ to 2016:IQ change in average weekly wage by county



- In the Quarterly Census of Employment and Wages (QCEW) Program, the Research and Analysis Bureau collects and compiles employment and wage data for workers covered by Nevada unemployment insurance laws, and federal civilian workers covered by Unemployment Compensation for Federal Employees.
- The most recent QCEW information shows that average weekly wages in Nevada as a whole increased 1.1% from 2015:IQ to 2016:IQ
- Change in weekly wages range from -4.2% (Esmeralda) to 7.4% (Storey). Nine of 17 counties experienced an increase in average weekly wages.
- As for Nevada's major population centers, Carson City, at -3.3%, realized a decline in wages. Washoe County experienced a slightly slower growth rate than the Silver State, at 0.4%. Clark County is slightly above Statewide growth, at 1.5%.
