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Longitudinal Employer-Household Dynamics Job to Job Flows

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LEHD Job-to-Job Flows and its relevance to Nevada:

The LEHD (Longitudinal Employer-Household Dynamics) Job-to-Job Flows data provides information about the movement of workers between jobs within a specific geographic area over time. In the context of Nevada, LEHD Job-to-Job Flows data that specifically focus on job transitions and employment patterns within the state of Nevada.

Job-to-Job Flows from All 50 U.S. States to Nevada in the Third Quarter of 2022: The largest influx is observed from California with 7,613 workers, followed by Texas with 1,444 and Utah with 927. The majority of these workers are aged over 45.

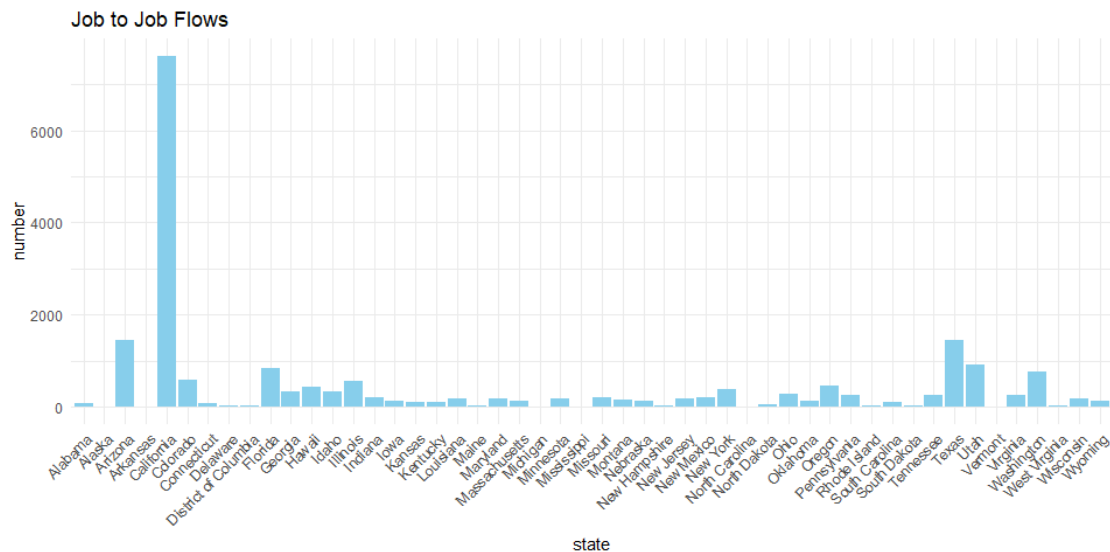
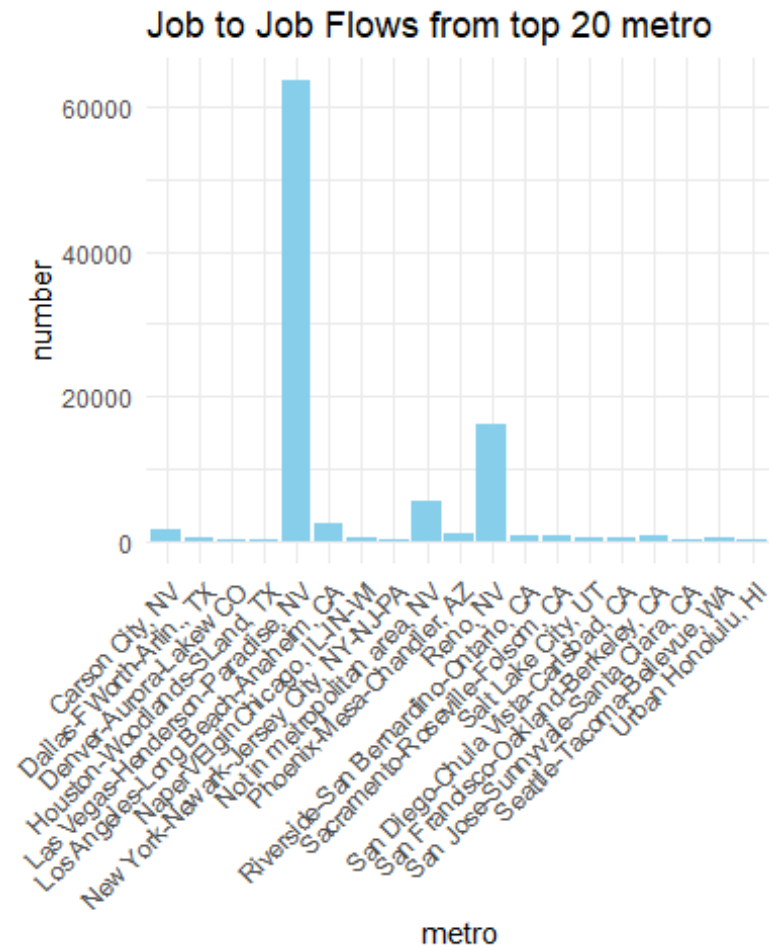

Job-to-Job Flows from Metropolitan Areas to Nevada in the Third Quarter of 2022:

Among the metropolitan areas outside of Nevada, the top three sources are Los Angeles-Long Beach-Anaheim, CA with 2,542, Phoenix-Mesa-Chandler, AZ with 963, and San Francisco-Oakland-Berkeley, CA with 906.



Job-to-Job Flows to Various Industries in Nevada in the Third Quarter of 2022:

The highest volume of job flows occurs in the Accommodation and Food Services sector, with 20,798 individuals. This is followed by the Administrative and Support and Waste Management and Remediation Services sector, which sees 12,865 individuals finding new

jobs, and the Retail sector, with 11,799 individuals. In the Health Care and Social Assistance sector, there are 10,009 job flows.

Conversely, the Utilities sector records the lowest job flows, with just 218 individuals, and the Agriculture, Forestry, Fishing, and Hunting sector has 339 individuals moving to new jobs.

Average quarterly earnings following hires to stable employment (short or no observed nonemployment spell). Shows the Accommodation and Food Services with 10,599, Administrative and Support and Waste Management and Remediation Services with 12,500, Retail Trade 11,222 and Health Care and Social Assistance 15,345.

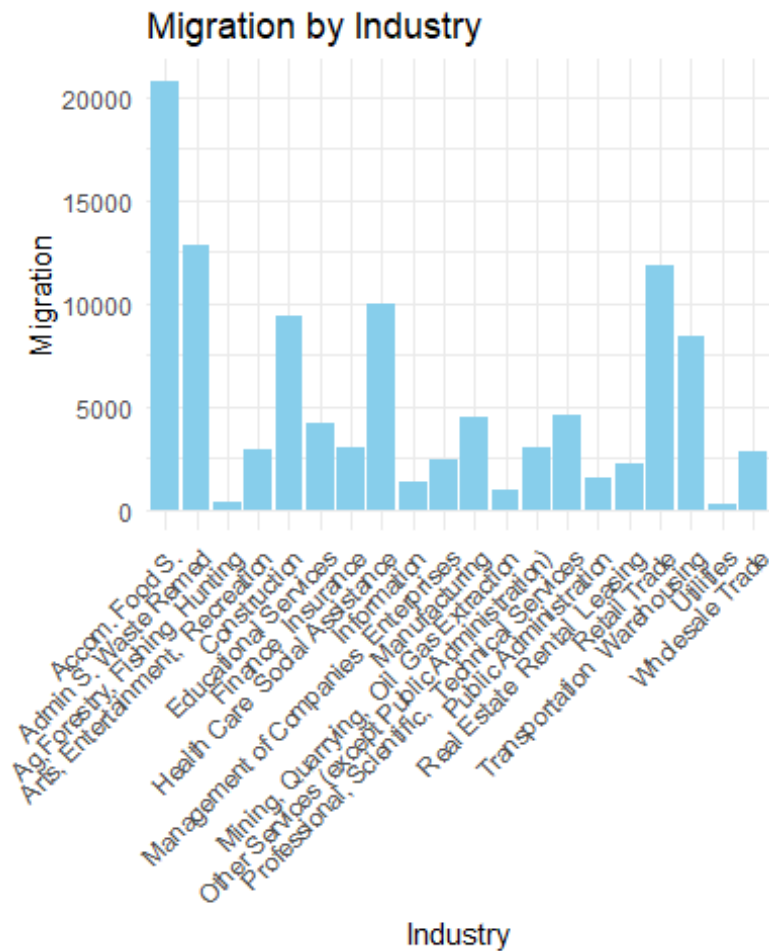
